- **Preventing Learning Loss Webinar Series & Coaching Sessions** - While summer learning loss is well documented, the period of time when students will not be in classrooms will likely double due to the virus. Aimed at intentionally preventing learning loss and providing schools with coaching + planning support that incorporates: Applying the Research to Prevent Learning Loss & Create Gains; Motivating & Engaging Students + Families; Resolving Barriers & Extending the Reach through Community Partnerships; and, Finalizing your Strategic Learning Loss Prevention Plan & Getting Friendly Feedback.
- **"Coping with Crisis"** - Social Emotional Learning Curriculum Units for elementary, middle and high school students to support emotional well-being as they return to school accompanied by Teacher Professional Development to support unit delivery.
- **A "Daily Dose" of Social Emotional Learning Programming** - Sent to teachers weekly to provide assistance as they coach students and deliver remote instruction. Includes tips for teachers, activities for students and parent outreach ideas and information.
